

RANGE SAFETY RULES

- 1. Read and understand the rules posted in the clubhouse.**
- 2. Rifle only, no handguns.**
- 3. Maximum calibre allowed; centre fire rifle .50 in., rimfire .44 in., black powder .80 in., shotgun 10 ga.**
- 4. Tracer and armour piercing bullets prohibited.**
- 5. Paper targets only.**
- 6. If you are unfamiliar with your rifle, sight it in at the 25 yard range before attempting the 100 yard rifle range.**
- 7. All guests must sign a waiver and be supervised.**
- 8. Range operational not prior to ½ hour before sunrise and ½ hour after sunset.**
- 9. Discharge firearms only from the bench with the muzzle extended through the shooting port.**
- 10. One shooter at a time.**
- 11. If more than one person is participating, one person must be the range officer.**
- 12. Eye and ear protection is mandatory for all participants and for anyone in close proximity.**
- 13. A green flag indicates range is safe. Wait until an all clear is called before going down range.**
- 14. A red flag indicates that the range is active and it is not safe to go down range.**
- 15. When a cease fire is called stop firing immediately; make your firearm safe; leave the action open and step away from the bench.**
- 16. Do not approach firing line or touch anything on the bench during a ceasefire.**
- 17. Never resume fire until the commence fire command has been given by the range officer.**
- 18. Pick up your spent casings and leave the range tidy.**
- 19. Clean up paper targets and put all recyclables in barrels supplied.**
